SYNOPSIS

Like so many Aussie kids, sisters Adelaide and Lucinda Miller were partially brought up by their nanna Ann, "Nansie". Roles were reversed when Nansie was diagnosed with dementia in 2018. Now adults, Adelaide and Lucinda are initially frustrated and confused about Nansie's unpredictable behaviour, but as they embark on a four-year journey of discovery – one that tests the limits of what is possible within the confines of the disease as well as themselves as occasional carers for their grandmother – they also learn to accept things and to appreciate Nansie more than ever.



HOST A GROUP SCREENING


Organise a special screening for your community, organisation, or members. Partner with local cinemas or book a private screening.

SCHOOLS & EDUCATION

The documentary will be available for schools to share with their students, followed by an optional in-person or online Q&A with subjects Adelaide and Lucinda Miller.

This film was made by young people, for young people, and the sisters believe it is vital for students to engage with this topic—whether it's about dementia, personal journeys, the filmmaking process, or the power of storytelling.



SCREENING FAQs

1. Who can host a screening?

Anyone! Whether you're part of a dementia advocacy group, a women's health network, a university, or a local film club, we'd love to help you bring *Nansie* to your audience.

2. Where & when can I screen the film?

You're welcome to host a screening at any time, at a cinema, a community hall, club, or anywhere there is an ability to project the film. *Nansie* is a timeless story that resonates well beyond its initial release.

3. How do I organise it?

Contact us and we'll help you organise a cinema screening. We'd need the number of seats you're expecting and your preferred dates. We recommend planning at least 4 weeks of promotion in advance.

4. Can I fundraise?

Yes. Approved screenings can charge above-cost ticket prices to raise funds. Just be sure to discuss this with us first.

Absolutely. Just notify us so we can schedule time after the screening.

6. Can I promote the screening myself?
